

Section 11- Glossary of Terms

ASN Advanced Shipment Notification. ASN is information about a shipment,

sent by suppliers before the shipment arrives, which allows the service center to plan for the shipment receipt. ASN should include date and time

of shipment arrival, PO numbers, vendor, SKUs, and quantities.

Bar Code A series of vertical bars and spaces containing coded information. Bar

codes may represent letter, numbers, or an alpha/numeric combination. Bar codes are designed to be read electronically, such as with a bar code

scanner or laser scanner.

BOL Bill of Lading. Document produced during shipping, at a shipment or trailer

level, which tells exactly what is being shipped.

Cancel Date First date with no notification from the Vendor where

Footlocker.com/Eastbay can close a PO and apply a charge.

Code 128 Bar code type/symbology currently used by Footlocker.com/Eastbay for

product identification.

Expected Date 30 days before the cancel date and having the ability to sell the product to

the consumer.

FOB Freight on Board. Indicates the title transfer.

Inner Carton A polybag, box or bundle (which contains product packed in multiples),

placed inside a master (outer) carton.

LTL Less Than Truckload or Common Motor Carrier. A company that

transports shipments, regardless of size or weight, for many shippers to

many destinations.

Manifest A shipping document used to identify and control product shipped.

Master BOL Master Bill of Lading. A bill of lading describing the contents of the entire

trailer, which may include information form stop and/or other bills of lading.

Master Carton May also be referred to as "outer carton". The outer most carton of

packaging. The carton in which the product is shipped to our final

destination (as opposed to inner cartons).

Packing List A list prepared by the Vendor by purchase order, detailing the items

shipped by style, size, the number of cases shipped and how it was

packed

Parcel Shipment Orders shipped via a parcel of small package carrier such as FedEx or

UPS.

PO Purchase Order – Document created by buyers and sent to Vendors to

request merchandise to be sent. POs are also used by the service center during receipt to ensure that the item and quantity received match what

was ordered.

PRO Number A receiving control number, which refers to a series of PO #s.

Routing Instruction Specific instructions as to trucking company to be used when shipping to

our service center. The Traffic Department assigns these carriers.

Service Center A central receiving and shipping point, which holds stock for shipments to

customers.

Ship Date Date shipments are sent so they arrive either on the expected date and no

later than the cancellation date.

UCC128 A case license plate bar code that provides a unique identification number

on a carton shipping label.

UPC Universal Product Code – A unique number code used to identify product.
